Project description

The goal of the project:

- to exchange of knowledge and experience within the topic of cluster policies and their influence on the development of cluster organizations, i.e. their viability in the V4 countries

The results will cover:

- recommendations & best practices for development of V4 cluster policies for strengthening V4 competitiveness

Detailed description of the project

The goal of the project is to:

- compare different approaches of cluster policies in the V4 countries including supporting institutions
- to analyse historical development and current stage of the cluster organisations in these countries from different points of view and their impact on the regional development.

Methodology of the research in the individual countries will be used in the same manner at two levels:

- i) **level of governments and agencies** supporting cluster organisations development within the national and regional dimensions
- ii) **level of cluster organisations managers**

Detailed description of the project

Data collection:

Secondary data for research will be collected employing government strategic documents content analysis and utilizing statistical data concerning financial support.

Primary data will be assembled as a result of the survey, that will be conducted by the form of semistructured interviews.

The evaluation of data results in:

1. revealing conditions of cluster organisations in the V4 countries,
2. identification of best practices,
3. providing recommendation for cluster policies improvement within the Cluster Policy Reports in each V4 country
