






Slovakia - programmes - national level (comparison in time)

Responsible organization SIEA has been established by the Ministry of Economy of the Slovak Republic as a professional state subsidy organization

General introduction of the best practice

- Implementator of Scheme de Minimis
- Responisble body for: projects focused on clusters (ClusterCOOP), elaboration of various analysis and studies focused on clusters, clusters policy and clustering.
- Main lessons learned (- concerning this practice)
 - Experiences with cluster support.
 - Realized studies and analysis about situation in clusters' environment in the Slovak Republic
 - Expert activities and presentations of industrial cluster organizations.
 - First official proposal of Cluster policy in study "Cluster policy in Slovak conditions". The publication deals with a comparison of different cluster policies, and highlights the requirement to implement a systemic assistance for clusters in Slovakia.
