Innovation Fund 2024 Net Zero Technologies – Clean-tech manufacturing

- This call supports the **construction and operation of manufacturing facilities** for clean-tech components that enhance renewable energy, energy storage, and hydrogen technologies.
- Applicants can develop **activities** in the project related to:
 - Manufacturing of Clean-Tech components for:
 - Renewable Energy: Solar panels, wind turbines, ocean energy, geothermal, and grid connection components.
 - Energy storage solutions: Batteries (excluding battery cell manufacturing for EVs) and long-duration storage
 - Heat pumps: Development and production of heat pumps.
 - Innovation in manufacturing products:
 - Lower costs, improved performance, efficiency, durability, and system integration.
 - Production Processes: Increased recycling, efficient material use, automation, and digitalisation.
 - Recycling & circular economy: funding for recycling or reusing critical materials used in clean-tech manufacturing.

- This call aims to fund **innovative low-carbon technologies and processes** that significantly reduce climate change impacts in industries.
- Funding categories: Large-Scale Projects; Medium-Scale Projects; Small-Scale Projects
- Applicants can develop **activities** in their proposals related to:
 - Innovation in Low-Carbon Technologies & Processes
 - Carbon Capture & Storage (CCS)
 - Innovative Renewable Energy & Energy Storage Technologies

Demonstration of stationary fuel cells in renewable energy communities

- This call aims to demonstrate integrated renewable energy systems using stationary fuel cells in renewable energy communities. The focus is on showcasing hydrogen-based energy generation to improve energy efficiency, grid reliability, and community empowerment in the clean energy transition.
- Projects results are expected to contribute to, for example:
 - Support the industrialisation of European fuel **cell technology**
 - Demonstrate **hydrogen-based** combined heat and power (CHP) systems
 - **Reduce energy costs & emissions** through demand-side strategies
 - Empower citizens and support EU energy & climate policies
- At least one partner must be a member of Hydrogen Europe or Hydrogen Europe Research

Innovative hydrogen and solid carbon production from renewable gases/biogenic waste processes

- This call focuses on developing breakthrough technologies to convert renewable gases (biogas, biomethane), biogenic solid waste, and advanced feedstocks into hydrogen and high-value solid carbon. The goal is to enhance circularity, decarbonisation, and EU energy security while reducing dependency on fossil-based hydrogen and imported raw materials.
- Projects results are expected to contribute to, for example:
 - Advanced low-emission technologies for converting renewable sources into hydrogen & carbon
 - Strengthening the European technological capacity for **clean hydrogen and carbon** production
 - Sector coupling with chemicals, steel, and materials industries for **resource efficiency**
 - Enhanced **energy security** by promoting EU-based renewable hydrogen production
 - **Reducing geopolitical risks** relating to the development of clean technologies, including hydrogen technologies
- Consortium must include a member of Hydrogen Europe or Hydrogen Europe Research
