# Challenges for EU industry and economy

#### What is at stake

- Competitiveness and resilience
- **Global race** for critical technologies
- Investment needs for transition
- Private capital not at scale
- Outward forces in the Single Market
- Constraints on EU budget
- Need for a European response

#### **Industry feedback**

- Fragmented/complex offer of EU funding, need for clear timelines and success rates
- Lack of advisory and support services, mentorship programmes
- Need for user-friendly portal
- Added-value Seal: helping securing financing



# STEP In a nutshell



- Not a new fund: pooling funding from 11 EU existing programmes, with a top-up of €1.5bn
- Thriving for efficiency: use of existing instruments / networks / processes
- Seamless articulation direct / indirect / shared managed funds
- Connecting with implementing partners (EIB, EIF, NPBIs)
- A service-oriented team to support STEP sectors
- User-centric portal
- In line with a future new Competitiveness Deal
- Regulation entered into force on 1 March 2024





#### EU Industry I Competitiveness I Strategic Technologies

The Strategic Technologies for Europe Platform (STEP) was set up by the EU to support European Industry and boost investment in **critical technologies** in Europe.

STEP will raise and steer funding across 11 EU programmes to three target investment areas:

- · Digital technologies and deep-tech innovation
- · Clean and resource efficient technologies
- Biotechnologies

STEP also supports projects growing **skills** necessary to the development of those critical technologies. STEP introduces a new STEP Seal – an EU label







# Call for proposal to support innovative manufacturing technologies & processes in the Union for medicines production

- This action covers activities aimed at **developing support** for or innovations targeting the manufacturing of APIs, their intermediates and/or excipients, namely by developing:
  - a) **novel manufacturing processes and technologies**, e.g., additive manufacturing, continuous manufacturing and flow chemistry, and biomanufacturing technologies; combined or not with activities covering
  - b) **novel industrial manufacturing and facility designs**, e.g., modular manufacturing, smart manufacturing execution systems, including automation and robotics, advanced analytics, and smart sensors, among other.

- Deadline: 05 September 2024

# Experimentation and exchange of good practices for value creation

- Projects are expected to contribute to the following outcome:
  - Value creation and transfer to the economy and society by increased interlinkages and cooperation between knowledge valorisation actors (academia/research; industry/SMEs; public administration/policy-makers and society/citizens);
  - **New solutions to societal and economic challenges** by stronger uptake and deployment of research results, including through the involvement of citizens and civil society;
  - Improvements of structures, strategies, practices and skills for knowledge valorisation through sustainable reforms and new initiatives in line with the ERA Policy Agenda action 7 Upgrade EU guidance for a better knowledge valorisation

  - Knowledge and understanding of the policy implications of adaptation solutions is increasingly utilised in the policy cycles at EU, national, and regional and local levels
  - The wide range of solutions tested and deployed in the context of the EU Mission on Adaptation to Climate Change and the good practices emerged in its Community of Practice are harvested, analysed and systematised to support the implementation of the Mission Adaptation to Climate Change

# Design for adaptability, re-use and deconstruction of buildings, in line with the principles of circular economy (Built4People Partnership)

- Among others, proposals are expected to address all of the following:
  - Validate construction and renovation solutions based on the integration of innovative tools, products, techniques, processes and methods, that facilitate deconstruction and reuse, based on life-cycle approaches across the value chain
  - **Deliver guidance and recommendations** for technology providers, regulatory authorities, certification and standardisation bodies, and define and implement ambitious dissemination actions, to promote the approaches demonstrated and support their replication
  - Where relevant, contribute through specific and targeted actions to **standardisation and regulatory evolutions** that can foster reuse and deconstruction of buildings materials and products.
  - Contribute to the activities of the Built4People partners and to the Built4People network of innovation clusters
