Call for Expression of Interest: Clusters meet Regions



The European Cluster Collaboration Platform, on behalf of the European Commission, will be coordinating a further 10 European 'Clusters meet Regions' workshops throughout 2025.

The **objective** of this <u>Call for Expression of Interest</u> is organising a European workshop 'Clusters Meet Regions' with the aim to strengthen EU industrial ecosystems and regional economies by **fostering collaboration** between **clusters** and **regional authorities**.

Who can apply?

This call for applications is addressed to any cluster stakeholder who is either actively participating in, or interested in, the economic development of their region. It is open to institutions such as clusters, regional agencies for economic development, and business network groups. Please note that a letter of support from your regional authority is needed if you want to apply. Proposals from national and/or regional authorities are also welcomed.

The **application** must be filled out in **English**.

▲ DEADLINE 20 December 2024 - 18:00 CET







The <u>EU Business Hub</u> is an EU-funded programme which supports EU companies active in the **green** and **low-carbon technologies, digital solutions,** and **healthcare** and **medical equipment** sectors to enter the two Asian markets by organising 10 business missions to **Japan** and 10 business missions to the **Republic of Korea** over the next four years. 50 EU SMEs and startups will be selected for each business mission. The objective of this programme is to **assist EU SMEs** and **start-ups** in their **expansion** to these **Asian** countries.

Participants also benefit from logistical assistance, a € 1,000 EU contribution for accommodation, and optional co-financed services like legal, translation, and printing support.





10 years of S3 implementation under Cohesion Policy

Smart Specialisation: An innovation policy concept designed to enhance regional innovation by enabling regions to focus on their strengths and comparative advantages.

- **Strategic Impact:** Smart Specialisation has significantly influenced the design of innovation strategies in European regions, fostering cooperation at various levels.
- ☐ The three pillars of S3 Localisation, Prioritisation and Participation are now integral to EU regional policy and development strategies.
- **S3 scope enlarged to reflect new challenges:** increased focus on core principles (governance, stakeholder management, M&E) + new elements (innovation diffusion, industrial transition and interregional cooperation)
- **New European Innovation Agenda (2022)**: S3 as a coordination principle to strengthen innovation ecosystems across EU and support key EU priorities.












Participation to Thematic Smart Specialisation Platforms









Interregional Innovation Investments Strand 1

- This call aims to **support interregional innovation investments by fostering collaboration across regions** focusing on:
 - Building interregional value chains.
 - Supporting SMEs and innovation actors from less developed regions.
 - Bridging the innovation divide in Europe.
- The thematic areas are:
 - Digital transition: Innovative digital solutions (AI, big data, cybersecurity), digital transformation of public services (e.g., e-government, healthcare), upskilling for digital technologies.
 - Green transition: Investments in decarbonisation and renewable energy, circular economy and sustainable business models, smart cities and green technologies.
 - Smart manufacturing: Advanced manufacturing solutions (AI, robotics, 3D/4D printing), circular production and carbon-neutral processes, innovation diffusion and SME participation in EU value chains.

Interregional Innovation Investments Strand 2a

- The call aims to **bridge the innovation divide by fostering economic cohesion and supporting innovation** ecosystems in less developed regions, enabling their integration into interregional and cross-border value chains.
- Projects are expected to contribute to the following outcome:
 - Integration into interregional and cross-border value chains with more developed regions.
 - Improved public services (user-friendly, accessible, interoperable).
 - Contributions to the European Green Deal, climate goals, and sustainability.
 - Strengthened regional capacity for co-investment and innovation alignment with Smart Specialisation Strategies.
- The expected impact is:
 - Short-term: New value chains, innovation diffusion, SME participation.
 - Long-term: Increased EU competitiveness, reduced innovation divide, economic growth, and alignment with the European Green Deal.

Maritime regional cooperation fostering Smart Specialisation and Innovation in the Sustainable Blue Economy (Topic 1)

- The objective of this call topic is to animate and underpin the S3 Thematic Platform for Sustainable Blue Economy with strategic interregional partnerships that develop and implement highly innovative solutions addressing priorities in the EU sustainable blue economy (i.e. decarbonisation of the blue economy sectors, energy transition, sustainable fisheries and aquaculture, circular blue economy, new forms of aquaculture, including algae, coastal resilience and marine litter prevention, sustainable food systems, and green coastal and maritime tourism).
- This call for proposal is **complementary to strand 1** (Interregional Innovation Investments) of the I3 Instrument.
- Projects are expected to contribute to the following outcome:
 - Enhanced interregional cooperation, creating and integrating value chains across regions with shared or complementary innovation priorities.
 - Reduction of the innovation divide by enabling less developed regions to access and apply innovative technologies and solutions.
 - · Development of sustainable and competitive regional economies through targeted innovation initiatives.

Joint EUROCLUSTERS for Europe's recovery

- This call focuses on reinforcing innovation and adoption of new technologies for **strategic autonomy**. In particular, the emphasis is on **value chains** within or across one or more of the 14 industrial ecosystems identified in the European Industrial Strategy.
- The call is divided into two strands:
 - Strand 1 focuses on net-zero technologies and critical raw materials:
 - Strand 2 covers value chains not covered in Strand 1.
- Number of projects to be funded: 16 (with at least 8 projects for Strand 1)
- Maximum project duration: 36 months
- Budget: 42 million EUR

- Deadline: 05 February 2025
